"Recent Research from India's National Family Health Survey"

Drs. Retherford and Mishra will provide a quick overview of the National Family Health Survey project and then summarize results from research on (1) the effect of cooking smoke from biomass fuels (wood or dung) on the prevalence of tuberculosis, (2) the effects of mass media exposure on knowledge and use of oral rehydration therapy for childhood diarrhea, and (3) the effects of religion on contraceptive use, opposition to contraception, and fertility.
